Bidders must take due notice and be governed accordingly. The addendum must be acknowledged as indicated in the Invitation to Bid or your Bid may not be considered.

Questions and Answers

- 1. Who is to repave the section of asphalt to be demo?

 The valley gutter shall be tied into the existing asphalt per plans.
- 2. No bid items for Class A concrete to fill voids
 This shall be included in the price of curb and gutter.
- 3. Do you need a shoulder behind curb or is the slope from back of curb? The slope should be at a 4:1 or flatter as per plans.
- 4. Do you need GAB in pavement area? Concrete shall be placed on 6" of GAB.
- 5. How thick should the concrete valley gutter be on this project? Specifications on page 6 of 24, item number 441-4020 conc valley gutter 6 in. Plans dated 12-14-22 page 2 has typical valley gutter detail states 6" minimum thickness class A concrete. Bid form page 19 of 24, item # 0030 concrete valley gutter 8 in.
 - The plans are correct, the concrete shall be at a depth of 6 inches.
- 6. Upon visiting the area/road, the existing asphalt at the edge of the pavement and driveway entrances appear to be alligatored (deteriorating). There likely will not be a way to maintain its integrity when saw cutting and the removal of asphalt. With all this taken into account, what is the plan if remediation is needed?
 - The plans (sheet one) call for the two lower driveways to have the asphalt removed and pour valley gutter in place. The City Public Works personnel will mark the limits of the driveways to be cut out.
