• Added new features to dahlonegadda.org website for easier use, including a "Resources for Small Business Development" tab and a "Job Opportunities" tab.

- Managed all postings for City of Dahlonega website and social media for the month.
- Attended monthly Downtown Dahlonega Business Association, Chamber Board, and Tourism Board meetings.
- Hosted monthly community partners meeting with Chamber, Tourism, Visitors Center, and Lumpkin County Development Authority staff.
- Developed budget requests for FY2024.
- Interviewed candidates for Summer Assistant position.
- Finalized application for Friendly Faces: a volunteer team of ambassadors downtown.

Promotion:

- Scheduled all social media posts to celebrate Georgia Cities Week.
- Continuing joint advertising efforts between the Chamber, UNG, and Tourism staff.

- Attended plan review meetings with Planning and Zoning. Provided Business Welcome Packets and information on financial assistance.
- Booked fireworks vendor for July 4th and had safety meeting with UNG. LCSO, Dahlonega Police, and EMS/Fire.
- Organized vendors and sponsors for May First Friday Concert. Planned a food delivery system
 to the park with Shenanigan's Irish Pub to avoid bringing in non-local food trucks.
- Attended Business Improvement District training to learn more about business- district funded special projects.
- Contracted with a local broker to advertise and draft a lease for the Head House rental. The space is currently being advertised and DDA Board will review applicants in May.
