Water & Wastewater Treatment Department Report July 2023

July was a very busy and productive month. Both treatment facilities, lift stations, water distribution and cross-connection protection programs were inspected by the EPD. Never in the history of our City, or any other system that I know of, have all of these state mandated inspections been performed in the same week. It just happened to line up that week. No major findings were noted in the verbal reports but an official report will be sent to us in the near future. Once those reports are received, we will have 45 days to officially respond with our plan of action to correct any findings that they noted. We have officially received our Wastewater Discharge Permit and it went into effect August 1, 2023. This permit from the state is good for five years and has some new requirements that may require the City to seek the advise of engineers. On the last note, Clayton Pierce has officially become a Class 3 Water Treatment Plant Operator. He passed his state certification test on the first try which has a very low pass rate in the state of Georgia. We are fortunate to have a very knowledgeable young man working for us and will hopefully serve the citizens of Dahlonega for many years to come.
