Report Highlight: Two bids were opened on the Lime Feed System for the WWTP. Both

bids were considerably higher than expected with the low bidder (Willow Construction) at \$799,400. We are currently looking at our options for funding and once we have a solution it will be presented to the Council. We have asked Willow for an extension on the 60-day bid awarding contract while we explore our options. Now that we have entered the new year, we are getting busy gathering data for the annual water audit. This report is due on March 1st of every year and requires a lot of different departments in the city working together to complete this project.
