Report Title: Water & Wastewater Treatment Department Report February 2024

Report Highlight: The annual Water Audit was certified and submitted to the State before the March 1 deadline. No major changes in the leak index or score when compared to the previous water audit. We still stand at 27% “Nonrevenue Water” in our distribution system. There are some system changes being addressed this calendar year that will hopefully bring this number down as well as increase our revenue. Inspection of the Upper Crown Mountain Tank discovered some structural issues that will need to be addressed. This is the only bolted tank that we have for water storage and some of the nuts and washers are showing their age (Tank was installed in the early 1980’s). We are seeking expert advise on how to address this issue. There is no immediate threat to the tank but repairs or replacement will need to be performed in the near future.
