Promotion:

- The May First Friday Concert was held on Friday, May 3rd, at 6:30 p.m. Despite inclement weather, there was a large crowd.
- The Dahlonega Farmers Market began on Saturday, May 4th.
- Continuing joint advertising efforts between the Chamber, UNG, Tourism, and DALC staff.
- Continuing to promote the Dahlonega Dollars virtual gift card program.

Economic Vitality:
